SUMMARY OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 3. Support student development by providing high-quality feedback, pastoral care, and professional guidance in alignment with the Conservatoire's educational values

DUTIES:

The role-holder will:

- 1. Provide engaging, inclusive, and pedagogically sound teaching in classical conducting, supporting students across varied levels of experience.
- 2. Supervise student ensembles where appropriate, enabling practical application of conducting techniques and fostering collaborative performance skills.
- 3. Engage in curriculum planning and assessment, ensuring alignment with academic and industry standards.
- 4. Participate in departmental meetings, assessment panels, and other academic duties as required by the School of Music and Education.



- 5. Contribute to the Conservatoire's broader artistic and academic community, including student recruitment, open days, and performance events (where appropriate)
- 6. Comply with all conservatoire policies and procedures.
- 7. Participate in any staff development activities required to carry out the duties of the role effectively, and in the conservatoire Appraisal Scheme.
- 8. Any other reasonable duties commensurate with the level of the post, which may be required from time to time.

NOTES:

1. Duties will inevitably develop and change as the work of the conservatoire changes to meet the needs of its service. Employees should therefore expect periodic variations to role descriptions, and Leeds Conservatoire reserves this right. This role description will be supplemented on a regular basis by individual objectives derived from conservatoire strategies.
